FROM THE PASTOR DESK

Paul was angry at the Christians in the city of Galatia. He was rough with them, *“O stupid Galatians! Who has bewitched you . . . ? (Galatians 3:1-3)* This Letter to the Galatians is the only epistle of Paul which lacks a "thanksgiving" section. In every other epistle, Paul thanks his readers, but not here. Some people had come to the Galatians and told them that they had to be Jews before they were Christians. These had told them they had to be circumcised and such. However, instead of the “brand mark” of circumcision, Paul says that he bears the “brand marks” of Jesus in his body. Many have suggested Paul referred to perhaps the stigmata – or wounds of Christ. Yet more likely it simply means that Paul shares in his life the sufferings of Jesus on the cross. In today’s reading Paul boldly proclaims, *“May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.” (Galatians 6:14)* I think that we too should remember these words, particularly if we are hesitant or afraid of showing ourselves to be Catholics and face opposition. Have I ever shared my Catholic faith point of view with others when the Church’s view is out of favor with the world’s? Have I ever faced scorn or ridicule for doing what I know to be right and morally correct? Lord grant me the strength to embrace your path – even in great difficulty.

WORKING FOR A HIGHER CAUSE - PEACE, POWER & THE MISSIONARY -



Today’s gospel has Jesus sending out his disciples two by two. They are to pronounce peace over the household and remain there. Jesus promises peace to those who follow him – it’s a part of justice. But it’s also a part of the power of God. When we put Jesus’ word in the first place in our lives, we cultivate peace. Early American poet James Thoreau said, *“the mass of men lead lives of quiet desperation.”* How many search for peace but refuse to look at Jesus and his power? It clearly says they rejoiced, and they said, “. . . even the demons are subject to us because of your name!” And Jesus agrees with them. But he tells them to be happy, not because you’re seeing results, be happy because by sharing in my work, your names are written in heaven.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

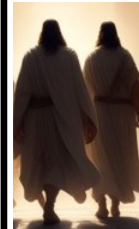
Pablo estaba enojado con los cristianos de la ciudad de Galacia. Él fue duro con ellos, *“¡Oh, gálatas insensatos! ¿Cómo se han dejado hipnotizar ustedes ...?” (Gálatas 3:1-3)*. Esta Carta a los Gálatas es la única epístola de Pablo que carece de una sección de "acción de gracias". En todas las demás epístolas, Pablo agradece a sus lectores, pero no aquí. Algunas personas habían venido a los gálatas y les habían dicho que tenían que ser judíos antes de ser cristianos. Estos les habían dicho que tenían que circuncidarse y cosas así. Sin embargo, en lugar de la "marca" de la circuncisión, Pablo dice que lleva las "marcas" de Jesús en su cuerpo. Muchos han sugerido que Pablo se refirió quizás a los estigmas, o heridas de Cristo.

Sin embargo, es más probable que simplemente signifique que Pablo comparte en su vida los sufrimientos de Jesús en la cruz. En la lectura de hoy, Pablo proclama con valentía: *“Que nunca me gloríe sino en la cruz de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, por quien el mundo ha sido crucificado para mí, y yo para el mundo. (Gálatas 6:14)*. Creo que nosotros también deberíamos recordar estas palabras, sobre todo si dudamos o tememos manifestarnos como católicos y nos enfrentamos a la oposición. ¿He compartido alguna vez mi punto de vista sobre la fe católica con otros cuando la visión de la Iglesia no es del agrado del mundo? ¿He enfrentado alguna vez desprecio o burla por hacer lo que sé que es correcto y moralmente correcto? Señor, concédeme la fuerza para abrazar tu camino, incluso en las grandes dificultades.

TRABAJANDO POR UNA CAUSA SUPERIOR - PAZ, PODER Y EL MISIONERO -



El evangelio de hoy nos muestra a Jesús enviando a sus discípulos de dos en dos. Deben proclamar la paz en la casa y permanecer allí. Jesús promete paz a quienes lo siguen; es parte de la justicia. Pero también es parte del poder de Dios. Cuando priorizamos la palabra de Jesús en nuestras vidas, cultivamos la paz. El poeta estadounidense James Thoreau dijo: *«La mayoría de los hombres vive en una silenciosa desesperación»*. ¿Cuántos buscan la paz, pero se niegan a mirar a Jesús y su poder? Dice claramente que se regocijaron y dijeron: *«... ¡Hasta los demonios se nos someten por tu nombre!»*. Y Jesús está de acuerdo con ellos. Pero les dice que se alegren, no porque vean resultados, sino porque al compartir mi obra, sus nombres están escritos en el cielo.
