## **FROM THE PASTOR DESK**



Today is Corpus Christi Sunday - Because of great love for Jesus in the Eucharist, a movement began in 12th-century Belgium for a special feast to honor the Blessed Sacrament. Pope Urban IV first established the feast and commissioned the great Dominican St. Thomas Aquinas to compose liturgical texts for it. Our sequence (poem) at Mass, Laud, O Zion is one of those compositions. Our focus in this celebration is the Real Presence of Jesus in his body, blood, soul, and divinity all contained in the Eucharist that we receive and adore.

**And in today's Gospel** (Luke 9:11-17) Jesus miraculously feeds 5,000 with just 5 loaves of bread. The miracle of the multiplication of the loaves, when the Lord says the blessing, breaks and distributes the loaves through his disciples to feed the multitude, pre-figures the superabundance of this unique bread of His Eucharist. Saint Luke tells us, "They all ate and were satisfied." Can we say the same of our parish? Christ has given up His precious Body and Blood for us to feed upon so that we might have eternal life. This is Christ's greatest on-going miracle! If you eat you will be satisfied. Prepare yourself, and come feast at His holy table of "thanksgiving." **Fr. Charles**

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## **FROM THE PAROCHIAL VICAR DESK**

### **Corpus Christi: Catholics why do we process?**



The Eucharistic procession is a public act of worship that honors the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. It serves as a powerful expression of faith, bringing Christ into the streets and daily life of the community. This sacred tradition strengthens the devotion of the faithful, fosters unity in the Church, and proclaims the central belief that Christ is truly present in the Eucharist. By participating, we Catholics renew our commitment to live according to Christ's love and teachings, making His presence known in the world.

The Corpus Christi procession holds a deeply significant place in the Catholic Church, as it is a public expression of faith in the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. Celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday, or the following Sunday in some regions, the feast of Corpus Christi (Latin for "Body of Christ") was instituted in the 13th century and emphasizes the central mystery of the Catholic faith: that Christ is truly present body, blood, soul, and divinity in the consecrated host.

The procession typically involves carrying the Blessed Sacrament in a monstrance through the streets, accompanied by clergy, laypeople, choirs, and often children dressed in white. It is not only a liturgical act of devotion but also a powerful witness to the surrounding community. By taking the Eucharist outside the church walls, Catholics affirm that Christ's presence is meant to sanctify the world, not just the sanctuary.

Spiritually, the procession is a moment of reverence, prayer, and unity. It reminds the faithful of Christ's abiding presence and challenges them to live Eucharistic lives of self-giving love, charity, and service. As such, the Corpus Christi procession continues to be a vital and visible celebration of Catholic identity and belief in the Eucharist.

**Hoy es el Domingo de Corpus Christi.** Debido al gran amor por Jesús en la Eucaristía, en el siglo XII surgió en Bélgica un movimiento para celebrar una fiesta especial en honor al Santísimo Sacramento. El papa Urbano IV instituyó la fiesta y encargó al gran dominico Santo Tomás de Aquino la composición de textos litúrgicos. Nuestra secuencia (poema) en la Misa, Laud, Oh Sión, es una de esas composiciones. En esta celebración, nos centramos en la Presencia Real de Jesús en su Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad, todo contenido en la Eucaristía que recibimos y adoramos.

**Y en el Evangelio de hoy** (Lucas 9,11-17), Jesús alimenta milagrosamente a 5.000 personas con tan solo 5 panes. El milagro de la multiplicación de los panes, cuando el Señor da la bendición, los parte y los distribuye a través de sus discípulos para alimentar a la multitud, prefigura la sobreabundancia de este pan único de su Eucaristía. San Lucas nos dice: «Comieron todos y se saciaron». ¿Podemos decir lo mismo de nuestra parroquia? Cristo entregó su precioso Cuerpo y Sangre para que nos alimentemos de ellos y tengamos vida eterna. ¡Este es el mayor milagro continuo de Cristo! Si comes, quedarás saciado. ### **DEL ESCRITORIO DEL VICARIO PARROQUIAL**

#### **Corpus Christi: ¿Por qué los católicos, hacemos procesión?**



La procesión eucarística es un acto público de culto que honra la presencia real de Jesucristo en el Santísimo Sacramento. Sirve como una poderosa expresión de fe, llevando a Cristo a las calles y a la vida cotidiana de la comunidad. Esta sagrada tradición fortalece la devoción de los fieles, fomenta la unidad en la Iglesia y proclama la creencia fundamental de que Cristo está verdaderamente presente en la Eucaristía. Al participar, los católicos renovamos nuestro compromiso de vivir según el amor y las enseñanzas de Cristo, dando a conocer su presencia en todo el mundo.

**La procesión del Corpus Christi** ocupa un lugar muy significativo en la Iglesia católica, ya que es una expresión pública de fe en la presencia real de Jesucristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía. Celebrada el jueves después del Domingo de la Trinidad, o el domingo siguiente en algunas regiones, la fiesta del Corpus Christi (que en latín significa "Cuerpo de Cristo") fue instituida en el siglo XIII y enfatiza el misterio central de la fe católica: que Cristo está verdaderamente presente en cuerpo, sangre, alma y divinidad en la hostia consagrada.

La procesión suele implicar llevar el Santísimo Sacramento en una custodia por las calles, acompañado por clérigos, laicos, coros y, a menudo, niños vestidos de blanco. No es solo un acto litúrgico de devoción, sino también un poderoso testimonio para la comunidad circundante. Al llevar la Eucaristía fuera de los muros de la iglesia, los católicos afirman que la presencia de Cristo tiene como propósito santificar el mundo, no solo el santuario.

Espiritualmente, la procesión es un momento de reverencia, oración y unidad. Recuerda a los fieles la presencia permanente de Cristo y los anima a vivir una vida eucarística de amor abnegado, caridad y servicio. Como tal, la procesión del Corpus Christi sigue siendo una celebración vital y visible de la identidad católica y la creencia en la Eucaristía.
